TRAVEL NEWS - 2023 DAY TRIPS

April - Kew Gardens. We are unable to confirm the date as bookings are only being taken up to the end of March 2023 but it is anticipated this trip will be approximately £45. This will include Dews coach to London, admission and group tour. Please put your name on the sign-up sheet at the September meeting but deposits will not be taken until October when we hope to confirm the date and price. An option for members without the group tour will be considered at a price of £40 per person.

Thursday 6th July—Houses of Parliament & Thames River Cruise. This was a very popular trip, which had to be postponed due to Covid. This will include Dews coach to London, tour of the Houses of Parliament and river cruise up to Greenwich.
